- **Hot lunches** available Monday through Friday 11:30 – 12:30 with a drive thru pick up service.
- **Bag lunches** available Saturday and Sunday. No qualification requirements.
- **Food Pantry:** One Box available to qualified recipients every other month. Food pantry does have essential items available. Those in need of delivery due to inability to get out can call for arrangements.
